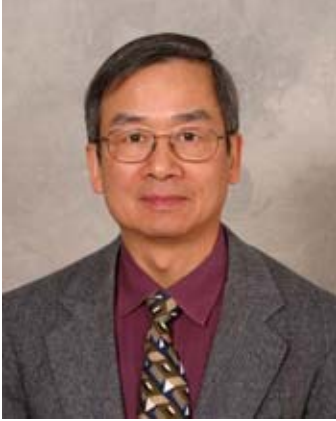
Dr. Bialon-Oster treats a large array of foot disorders, including:
